Leaves, grass, brush, and branches no larger than 4” in diameter can be brought to the town compost site located on East Belcher Road. While the town owns the land, the site itself is run by Tree Tech. The town compost site runs from April 4, 2022 thru Late November/Early December, Monday thru Saturday (except Holidays 7:30AM to 3:45PM).

Yard waste must be collected in either paper leaf bags or barrels clearly marked with “Yard Waste.” Containers should weigh less than 40 pounds and be set out for collection on your regular trash day during the weeks indicated on the calendar.

Norwood

Leaves must be placed in paper bags and will be collected curbside on the regular trash collection day from April through November. Bags must weigh less than 50 pounds. Residents can also drop off collected leaves at the Winter Street Composting Facility located at 370 Winter Street on Saturdays from 8:00AM to 1:30PM, provided it is not a Hazardous Waste and Recycling Day.

Quincy

Yard waste is collected on your regular trash day during the highlighted weeks of this calendar. Place leaves, grass clippings and twigs into paper bags or in barrels marked with YARD WASTE stickers. Do not use PLASTIC BAGS. Free yard waste stickers are available at the DPW, City Hall and the Kennedy Senior Center and are required on yard waste barrels. Branches must be cut into 3-foot lengths and cannot be thicker than 2.5 inches. You may drop-off yard waste and recyclables at the DPW yard M-F, 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM, year-round weather permitting, and on Saturdays, April 3 through December 3, from 7:30 AM to 2:30 PM, weather permitting. December 3rd is the last Saturday the rear yard is open until April 2023.

Randolph

Curbside Yard Waste is picked up 6 times a year on the following dates: November 5th, November 19th, December 3rd (2022); April 15th, May 14th, and May 27th (2023). Yard waste is leaves, grass clippings, small branches / brush less than 1 inch diameter and 3 feet long.
